To Whom It May Concern:

I am providing this letter of support for the Broadband Deployment Program (BDP) grant application Qwest d/b/a Centurylink, (Lumen) is submitting to the Oregon Broadband Office for Burlington. This project will bring fiber-based internet services to over 300 unserved and underserved locations in the Burlington project area.

Many of the residents of Burlington have few, if any options, for internet service. Lumen's network could change this with financial assistance from Oregon's BDP program. Many homes and businesses in this area are considered unserved, with less than the FCC minimum speeds of 25/3 Mbps. Providing gigabit broadband with speeds of 940/940 Mbps will make a meaningful difference to our communities for economic development, better education, and healthcare, improving government services and in keeping our communities vital.

Many locations are considered unserved or only have access to expensive, unreliable satellite or point-to-point services. Many students are unable to complete the required schoolwork from home with these inadequate services.

Lumen has proven that it knows how to build, operate, and successfully manage wireline infrastructure to serve its more rural customers. Local communities and citizens know that they can depend on the services provided by Lumen/Centurylink.

Grant funds received from the program would be well utilized in reaching many underserved and unserved homes and businesses in the Burlington area.


